Learn the distinctions between western "best practices" in delivery methods and "practice based evidence" most often practiced in indigenous communities. Take a personal journey to assess your own internal and external biases and discuss stigmas and the misunderstandings that culture is not a necessary concern when creating prevention, intervention or cessation services.
