TELLING THE STORY OF YOUR FNL PROGRAM'S LOCAL IMPACT IS IMPORTANT FOR BUILDING SUPPORT WITH STAKEHOLDERS. IN THIS WEBINAR, STRATEGIC COMMUNICATION EXPERTS FROM LARSON COMMUNICATION WILL HELP ADULT ALLIES HONE THEIR PROGRAM'S NARRATIVE. PARTICIPANTS WILL HOW LEARN TO IDENTIFY DISTINCT LOCAL COMMUNITY PROBLEMS, THEIR FNL CHAPTER'S SOLUTIONS, AND THE IMPACT OF FNL'S WORK IN THE COMMUNITY.
